She owns a Degree in Education, majored in Music and English. Also has a Master Degree in Musicology.

She studies vocal technique and repertoire with Maestros Antonio Santos (Uni. of Indiana) and David Mason (Trinity College of Music). She is a baroque and belcanto specialist, also in world music and popular music, focused on jazz, celtic and folk music.

Her first appearance in Eduardo Tarilonte's work was in 'Forest Kingdom', a complete library of sounds, featuring an 'ethereal female voice'.

She currently sings in the jazz band 'Barmanouche' and in a classical duet ('Lakmé Duetto'). She is also member of Valladolid's main theatre choir 'Coro Amigos del Teatro Calderón' and teaches music and voice in a well known School in Valladolid, Spain.
