

INSTALLATION AND SETUP EAST WEST PRODUCTS


WELCOME

This guide will walk you through the installation of your East West Download Library/Software.

INTRODUCTION

1. After purchasing an **East West download product**, please first download and install the East West **Installation Center** according to your operating system. East West products use the widely available Pace/iLok copy protection. If you don't have an iLok account yet, you should register it now and remember/write down your iLok **user ID** - without an iLok account East West libraries cannot be activated. (an iLok USB dongle is not required, but is optional) <https://www.ilok.com/#!registration>
Now start the Installation Center and log in with your East West/Soundsonline account or create a new one.

2. If you do **not** already have an **iLok license** for the East West **OPUS software**, or this is your first East West product, you will need to register this product once using the following link: <https://eastwestsounds.com/register/>


LICENSE CODE:

REGISTER

Log in with your East West/Soundsonline account, enter your license code, and then click **REGISTER**.

Users **with** activated **OPUS software** can register their new product directly in the Installation Center. Select **Register Authorization Code** in the menu on the top right and enter the license code you received in our email, invoice or customer account. Then click **Submit**.

INSTALLATION OF OPUS Software

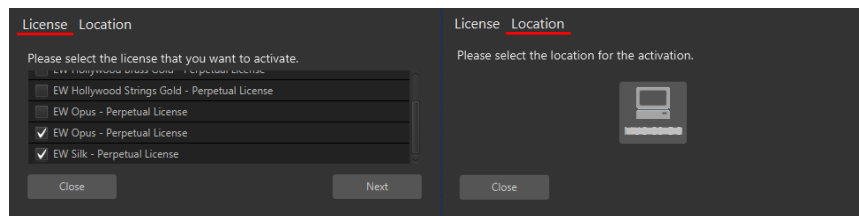

In the upper area of the **Installation Center** you will find the latest **OPUS software**, click on **Download**. As soon as the download is complete, the **OPUS Software Update Installer** will open automatically. Please follow the instructions to complete the installation of the **OPUS software**.


Attention: **OPUS** needs an activated iLok license to be used. If this is your first East West product, you will automatically get a free **OPUS license** after registration (see **introduction 2.**).

ACTIVATING THE LIBRARY / OPUS Software

1. Once your library is registered, **New licenses available** appears in the Installation Center - click **Activate** to the right of it. If this display is missing, please go to the top right menu  and select **Refresh Product List**.
2. Now select one or more products you want to activate (**License**) and a destination for the activation (**Location**): You can activate the product directly to the current computer or to a physical iLok USB dongle (optional).



Attention: If an error occurs during activation, please contact: licensing@eastwestsounds.com

3. The product now appears under **New Downloads** and can be downloaded. 
It is recommended to choose the location on a suitable, preferably fast hard disk or SSD and to create a corresponding folder there (e.g. **East West Libraries**).
The download will then be automatically unpacked and installed. Please be patient, depending on the size and internet speed the download may take a long time!

Attention: It is strongly recommended **not to** install the library content on your system hard disk!

LOADING AN INSTRUMENT

1. Start the **OPUS software** (standalone, or as plugin in your sequencer / DAW)
2. Now go to the browser view in **OPUS** and select your library. A list of instruments appears in a column on the right.
3. Go through the subdirectories until an **instrument** appears (file with the extension **.ewi**). Select an instrument and click **Add** (or Double click) to load the instrument. - You are ready to go!
